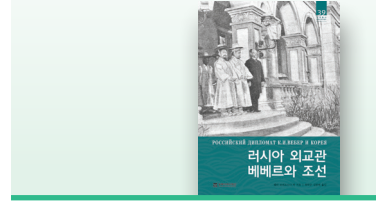

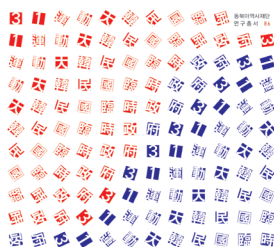

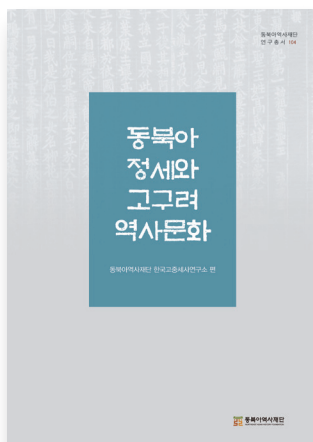

The second volume of *The Japanese Military “Comfort Women” Issue and Challenges* argues for the implementation of the victim-centered approach from the Basic Principles of Justice for Victims of Crime and Abuse of Power, unanimously adopted by the UN General Assembly in 2005, in order to resolve the comfort women issue and achieve historical justice. The book's third volume seeks to contribute to establishing a basis for a victim-centered resolution by identifying the perspective necessary to resolve the comfort women issue and by reviewing the extent of damage each region suffered.

To newly examine An Yong-bok's testimony to Bibyeonsa, Part 2 analyzes testimonies by An Yong-bok as well as other Japanese fishermen within the context of An Yong-bok's linguistic experience and the dispute's dual structure.

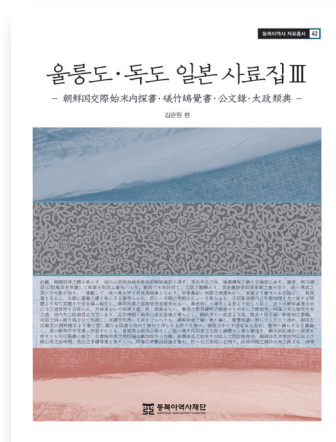
Since none of the Korean history books published prior to the Goryeo dynasty have survived, the *Dongyichuan* section in Chinese history books are sources that offer a glimpse of how the ancient Chinese viewed Korea prior to the Korean Three Kingdoms Period and how the view changed over time. This book features a collection of *Dongyichuan* excerpted from what is referred to as the "four histories of ancient China," *Shiji*, *Hanshu*, *Houhanshu*, and *Sanguozhi*. The second to fourth volumes are each devoted to the kingdoms of Koguryo (including the Yilou, Wuji, and Mohe), Silla, and Baekje to cover records about each kingdom in the Chinese sources *Jinshu*, *Tangshu*, and *Wudai shiji*.

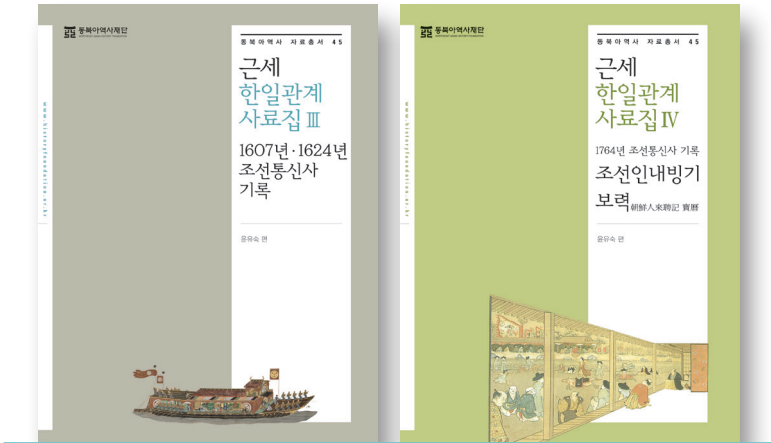

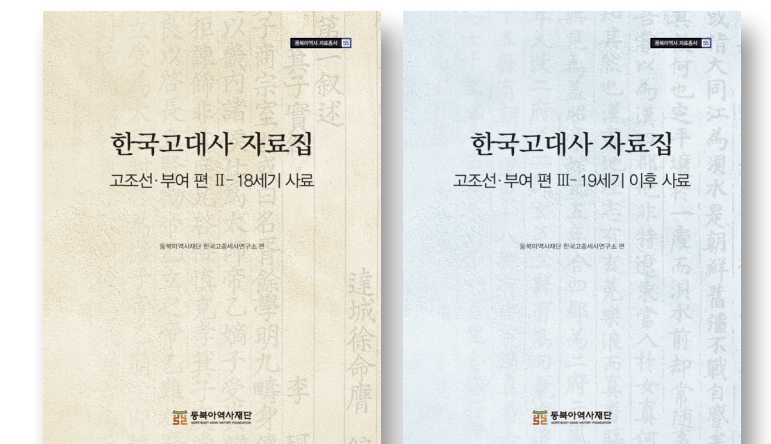

What is characteristic about sources from the eighteenth century tended to strengthen the argument for Mahan's legitimacy as the successor of Gija Joseon and to reassess Dangun Joseon. Historical research during the Joseon dynasty changed greatly after the nineteenth century so that in the field of documental archaeology, an empirical approach was adopted in studying figures and historical events involving Dangun and Buyeo.
